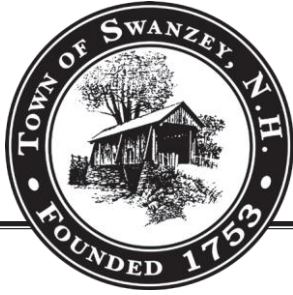

Town of Swanzev – Remote Participation in Public Meetings using ZOOM

To assist with social distancing to slow the spread of COVID-19 (coronavirus) the Town of Swanzev has begun using Zoom to allow residents to participate in public meetings remotely.

YOU DO NOT NEED TO HAVE A ZOOM ACCOUNT TO PARTICIPATE.

1. You may participate using a desktop/laptop computer, cell phone, landline, or tablet.
 - a. If using a desktop or laptop computer go to www.zoom.us
 - b. If using a smart phone or tablet you want to download the Zoom App from either the Apple App Store or the Google Play Store. For these devices you want to search “ZOOM Cloud Meetings” and you should see an icon that looks like:
 - c. If using a landline or cell phone, call the number on the public notice or invitation (**usually 1-929-205-6099**).

From our experience so far a computer seems to provide the best audio and video quality for you, followed by a smart phone or tablet using the Zoom app.

2. Once you have Zoom up on your computer or app, you want to click “Join a Meeting.”
3. When prompted for a Meeting ID, enter the # from the notice or invitation. Do not enter the ID number with the dashes, enter numbers only. Usually the Meeting ID for Town Meetings will be **235 370 4380**. When asked for a participant code, press #.
4. After you have joined, you will enter a waiting room until the meeting starts. You may need to click “Join Audio / Video” if you want to be heard / seen. **Please try to log in a few minutes before the start of the meeting in case you run into any issues.**

****PLEASE NOTE – all microphones will be muted unless the chair or meeting moderator is accepting public comment. Time will be allotted to ask and answer questions, but we must mute mics until permitted times to ensure audio quality. ****
